'Left Bank Bordeaux Cup' is an annual international wine competition for university students. First participation of HKUST Wine Team dated back to 2013. I have been involved in coaching since 2014. Each year, we recruit current students for training, followed by internal selection to pick the team members. Immediate past team will be responsible for liaison and recruitment for the following year.

In late 2015, it was my great pleasure to gather few other alumni to form a coach team. From then on, I could spare more time on HKUSTAWA matters.

Teamwork almost always works. I was very pleased to see HKUST Wine Team 2017 win LBBC Hong Kong Round and it was my honor to go with the team to Bordeaux (France) for wine tour cum final competition in June 2017. Result: we won the 4th place, after teams from France and Switzerland.

PROMOTING WINE CULTURE & STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

Following the success of last two years' wine teams, we plan to reach out to more current students and nurture the next generation of wine enthusiasts. Our first step was revisiting membership scheme. We decided to have a 'Student Membership' tier: current students can join our Association and pay for membership fee only *once* all through their years of study (instead of annual payment of membership fee). Upon their graduation, we will rebate the amount for Life-time Full Membership fee.

Next, we will look for opportunities to host wine tasting workshops for current students, especially undergraduates over 18 years old. Key objective is to promote wine culture, responsible drinking and equip them with social skills for the future.

Moving Forward

RELAX, HAVE FUN, AND DRINK TOGETHER

After a year of exploration and review of past achievements, we aim to do more in the coming year. We will continue seeking partnerships to bring exciting offers for members; we plan to host quarterly event (tentatively, May, August and November 2018) to pull together more alumni and students for expanding our circle of wine friends; and we will keep working with the University to support our fellow students.

MELCOMING NEW COMMITTEE & SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability of our Association is another key task to work on for 2018. We are aware of some new move among current committee members in their career, and therefore we will soon need some 'new blood' in our committee. I know some alumni are interested in joining us, but they hesitated because of a question in mind: "Do I have to be very knowledgeable in wines to be a committee member?" – My answer is: "Not necessary, but better you are interested in knowing wines and people."
